Getting there

VIECON - Vienna Congress & Convention Center is located in Vienna's 2nd district, approximately 10-15 minutes from Vienna city centre by public transport, depending on your starting point and connections.

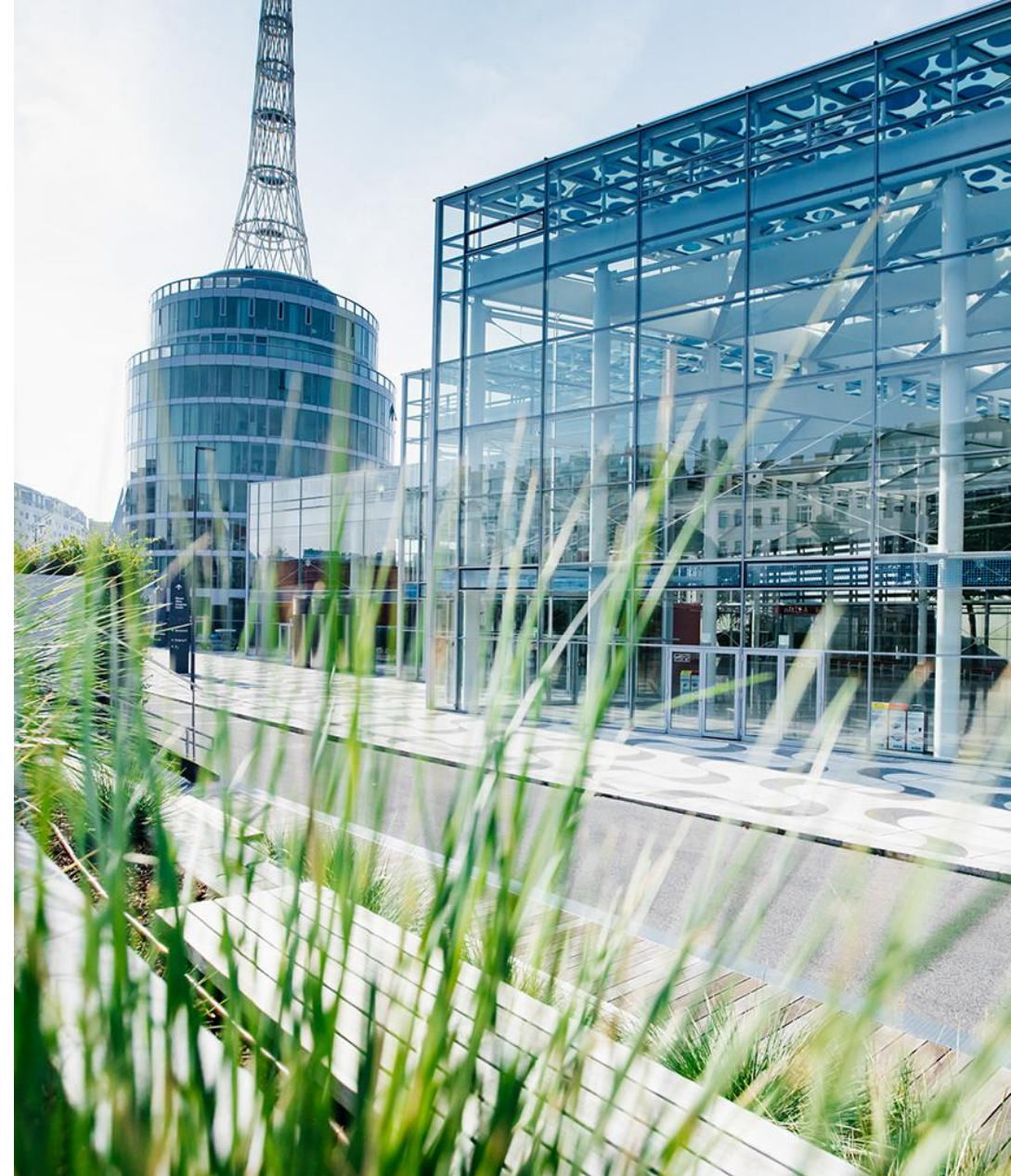
- **By public transportation**

The venue is directly connected to Vienna's public transport network via the U2 underground line. For Enlit Europe, take the U2 to Messe-Prater station for Entrance A. The venue is only a few minutes' walk from the station. From Vienna Central Station, the journey takes approximately 15-20 minutes by public transport.

- **By taxi**

A taxi from central Vienna generally takes around 10-20 minutes, depending on traffic. Taxis can be booked by phone or app, and Uber and Bolt also operate in Vienna.

Getting there

AIT Austrian Institute of Technology is located in northern Vienna, approximately 30-40 minutes from Vienna city centre by public transport, depending on your starting point and connections.

- **By public transportation**

The location is well connected to Vienna's public transit network via several bus and train lines. Bus lines to take: 29B - Paukerwerkstraße stop, 30A - Siemensstraße stop, 31A - H.-von-Buol-Gasse stop. Or take the train R1, R7, R, S1, S2, and S7 - Wien Siemensstraße Bahnhof station

From the bus stops and the Wien Siemensstraße Bahnhof station, you can reach the AIT location in just a few minutes on foot.

- **By taxi**

A taxi from central Vienna generally takes around 20-30 minutes, depending on traffic. Taxis can be booked by phone or app, and Uber and Bolt also operate in Vienna.

Hotel recommendations in Vienna

- **ARCOTEL Kaiserwasser Vienna**

Approx. public transport to AIT: ~25-30 min

Upper mid-range / 4-star superior. More upscale business-hotel option. Directly opposite Kaisermühlen/VIC U1 station

- **ARCOTEL Donauzentrum**

Approx. public transport to AIT: ~20-25 min

Mid-range to upper mid-range. Convenient location near Kagran U1 station, with easy connections towards AIT.

- **NH Danube City**

Approx. public transport to AIT: ~30 min

Upper mid-range / 4-star business hotel. Located near the Vienna International Centre and Kaisermühlen/VIC U1 station.

- **HOTEL SCHANI UNO CITY VIENNA**

Approx. public transport to AIT: ~25-30 min

Mid-range, modern design hotel. Located close to Kaisermühlen/VIC U1 station.
